ABOUT CODICILS

If you have already made a Will and you would like to leave a legacy to Merchant Taylors' School, you can do this by adding a codicil to your Will. A codicil is a document that amends or adds to an existing Will. You can find a form below. When making a codicil, please note the following:

- We would strongly advise you to seek legal advice before making any codicil.
- The 'suggested wording' (in separate enclosure) sets out wording that you could use to add details of the gift you wish to make to the School.
- You should not try to change your existing Will by crossing out or writing in new provisions as such changes will not be valid and could even affect the validity of your existing Will.
- In the same way as a Will, a codicil needs to be signed in the presence of two people who then need to sign the codicil and include their names, addresses and occupations.
- The codicil should be kept with your Will. It should not be attached to your Will.
